




KADUNA STATE UNIVERSITY CELEBRATES STAFF AMONG WORLD'S TOP 2% SCIENTISTS

This prestigious recognition places these scholars among the most cited researchers globally in their respective fields, reflecting the university's growing reputation for research excellence and international collaboration.

The Stanford-Elsevier World's Top 2% Scientists List is an independent global ranking of researchers whose publications are most frequently cited by peers worldwide.

It is compiled annually using Scopus data and a composite indicator that measures career-long and recent-year impact, taking into account citation quality, co-authorship patterns, and research field norms. The database covers over 200,000 scientists across 22 disciplines and 174 subfields, highlighting those within the top 2 percent of their fields based on objective citation metrics.

Being named in this list is therefore a mark of global scientific influence and a recognition of sustained, high-quality research contributions. It demonstrates how the honorees' scholarly outputs have shaped knowledge and advanced discovery at the international level.
