## **METHOD OF APPLICATION**

Interested applicants should visit the University Application Portal: <a href="http://applicant.safapply.com/kasucce">http://applicant.safapply.com/kasucce</a> for application procedures and the list of available programmes. Furthermore, applicants are required to pay a processing fee of N10, 000 (Nigerians) or \$20 (Non-Nigerians).

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

#### **Prospective Applicants Must Possess:**

- 1. Five (5) credit passes, including English Language and Mathematics, at O' Level in a maximum of two (2) sittings.
- 2. Direct Entry (DE) candidates shall, in addition to the minimum Five (5) credit passes (including English and Mathematics) in relevant programmes applied, shall also obtain the minimum 'A' Level points for the programme. E.g. NCE, Diploma shall be considered for admission into 200 Level.
- 3. Top-Up candidates shall, in addition to the minimum Five (5) O' Level credit passes (including English and Mathematics) in relevant programmes applied, shall also obtain HND or B.Sc. (with third class and NYSC Certificate) to be considered for admission into 400 Level.
- 4. Candidates who have graduated for five (5) years or above are to present Certificates instead of a Statement of Results.

- 6. Candidates offered provisional admission will be required to present the originals of their credentials at the point of registration.
