

STAKEHOLDERS REAFFIRM COMMITMENT TO KASU KAFANCHAN CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT



The Honourable Member representing Jema'a Constituency in the Kaduna State House of Assembly, Hon. Ali Kalat who visited alongside the Director General Kaduna State Facilities Management Agency has described his visit to Kaduna State University (KASU), Kafanchan Campus, as a familiarisation engagement aimed at strengthening relations with the University's leadership and gaining first-hand insight into activities at the campus.

Speaking during the visit, Hon. Kalat clarified that the engagement was purely developmental.
