KASU Hosts Kaduna State Government House Media Crew, Celebrates Winning Streak

The Vice Chancellor, Prof. Abdullahi Ibrahim Musa, described the event as an opportunity to showcase the remarkable achievements the university has recorded over the past few months. He expressed satisfaction in reporting that KASU has witnessed tremendous growth and success, emerging as a strong competitor among top universities in Nigeria and beyond.

During the last edition of the Nigerian University Games Association Games (NUGA Games), KASU athletes delivered outstanding performances. Speaking on academic excellence, the Vice Chancellor emphasized the university's dedication to quality teaching and innovative learning approaches. He noted that KASU lecturers are deeply committed to fostering critical thinking, creativity, and innovative problem-solving among students. In a landmark achievement, KASU became the only state university to participate in and win a grant in an agriculture-focused competition organized by the Tertiary Education Trust Fund (TETFund), underscoring its leadership in research and agricultural development. He also proudly mentioned that graduates from the university's Physics department have gone on to become astronauts, reflecting the institution's expanding global impact.



Prof. Musa also commended the Kaduna State Governor, Uba Sani, for his proactive leadership and unwavering support for education, acknowledging that the governor's contributions have been instrumental in driving the university toward excellence.

The Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academic), Prof. Yusha'u Ango, stressed the importance of effective knowledge delivery and revealed that KASU students have successfully embraced online and virtual learning platforms. He further disclosed that the university is making plans to introduce comprehensive distance learning programmes, a development that will expand access to quality education and add another milestone to KASU's growing list of achievements.

KASU Library Community Service Empowers Women




