KASU-Kafanchan Campus Gets Face-Lift as KADFAMA Hands Over Rehabilitation Works to Contractors

The Kaduna State University (KASU), Kafanchan Campus, is set for a major transformation following the official handover of key rehabilitation projects to contractors by the Kaduna State Facilities Management Agency (KADFAMA).

The handover ceremony, which took place on March 25, 2026, marked the commencement of a comprehensive upgrade of critical infrastructure across the campus. The intervention is part of efforts to enhance the learning environment and strengthen institutional capacity.

Speaking during the visit, representatives of KADFAMA outlined the scope and significance of the

projects, emphasizing government's commitment to revitalizing public institutions through strategic infrastructure development.

The projects cover the rehabilitation of faculty buildings, classrooms, offices, and student hostels, as well as plans for the landscaping of the campus environment.

The event brought together key stakeholders, including KADFAMA officials, university management and staff, contractors, consultants, and community representatives.

The College Secretary, alongside other campus officials, reaffirmed the institution's readiness to

support the successful execution of the projects.

A joint inspection of project sites was conducted to acquaint contractors and stakeholders with the locations and existing conditions. Following the inspection, project sites were formally handed over, with contractors pledging to commence work in line with agreed specifications and timelines.

KADFAMA stressed the importance of quality delivery, adherence to standards, and timely completion, while also highlighting the need for effective coordination among all parties involved. Minor concerns relating to site accessibility were

noted, with assurances that they would be addressed to ensure smooth implementation.

The rehabilitation initiative is expected to significantly improve infrastructure and overall aesthetics of the Kafanchan Campus, thereby creating a more conducive environment for teaching, learning, and research.

University officials expressed optimism that the intervention would further position KASU towards achieving excellence in line with ongoing reforms in Kaduna State's tertiary education sector.
