KASU Triumphs Again in National Competition



Students of the Estate Management Department at Kaduna State University (KASU) have once again demonstrated academic excellence by emerging winners in a national quiz competition organized by the Estate Surveyors and Valuers Registration Board of Nigeria.

The competition, held on 24th March 2026, featured top universities across the country. At the end of the keenly contested exercise, Kaduna State University led the table with 26 points, followed by University of Benin with 17 points and University of Uyo with 14 points. Bayero University Kano and Rivers State University recorded 6 points each.

This victory qualifies KASU to represent its group at the grand finale scheduled to take place in Lagos as part of activities marking the 50th anniversary celebration of ESVARBON, the regulatory body overseeing the estate management profession in Nigeria.

Speaking on the achievement, Kaduna State University Vice Chancellor Professor Abdullahi Ibrahim Musa expressed profound appreciation to academic staff for their dedication and commitment to quality teaching, noting that the success reflects the collective effort of the department and the university.
