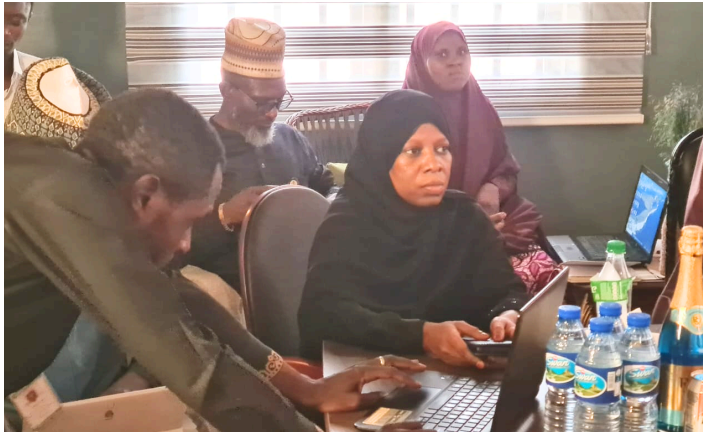

KASU COLLABORATES WITH TWL TO DEEPEN DIGITAL LEARNING INNOVATION

Kaduna State University (KASU), in collaboration with Technology Workforce Ltd (TWL), has introduced Cubbes, a new EdTech platform designed to enhance teaching efficiency and deepen student engagement.

The initiative forms part of ongoing efforts to equip lecturers with practical digital tools in response to the growing role of artificial intelligence in education.

At the engagement session, lecturers were introduced to the platform's capabilities, including seamless management of lecture materials, improved tracking of student attendance, and interactive features that promote active learning. Cubbes also offers AI-powered tools that enable students to generate summaries, quizzes, and study guides from course content, thereby strengthening understanding and retention.

Speaking at the event, Dr. Jamila Muhammad, Director of the Entrepreneurship and Research Development Centre(ERDC), urged participants to fully utilize the knowledge gained to advance academic delivery and institutional growth. She emphasized the importance of embracing innovation to position KASU for greater impact.

The programme, jointly hosted by KASU and TWL under an existing Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), primarily engaged staff of the ERDC. Organizers noted that the initiative will be expanded to benefit the wider university community in due course.
