## KASU SEEKS COLLABORATION WITH KADRA ON INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

**K**aduna state University KASU has initiated steps to strengthen its infrastructure base through strategic collaboration with the Kaduna Roads Agency (KADRA), as part of efforts to enhance teaching, learning, and the overall campus experience.

A KASU delegation led by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor Strategy, Innovation and Service Delivery, Professor Helen Afang Andow, paid a visit to the Managing Director of KADRA, Dr. Abdullahi Baba Ahmed, where discussions focused on critical infrastructure needs within the university,

The meeting explored possible partnership, particularly in road construction and rehabilitation across the university campuses. Key concerns raised included the need for improved access roads and the installation of speed calming measures along the main campus

corridor on Tafawa Balewa Way to ensure safety.

the delegation stressed the importance of these interventions noting that improved road infrastructure is essential for the safety and convenience of both students and staff

In response, the KADRA Managing Director expressed willingness to support the university through strategic interventions adding that such collaboration aligns with the agency's mandate of improving road infrastructure across Kaduna State. He further disclosed that the new road has been constructed along the axis of the institution's Permanent Site, with plans to connect it to the Eastern Bypass.

The KASU delegation also included Professor Tukur Abdulkadir and Director Physical Planning Architect Ezekiel Marcus
