

KASU RECEIVES REVIEWED SALARY AND WELFARE DOCUMENTS FOR NON-TEACHING STAFF IMPLEMENTATION

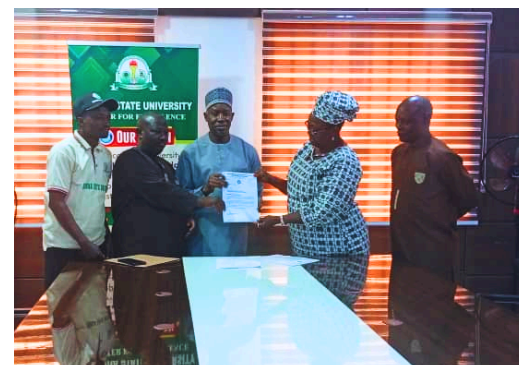
Kaduna State University (KASU) on Thursday 9th of July 2026, received the reviewed salary and welfare documents for non-academic staff following the presentation of the renegotiated working document between the Federal Government and the Joint Action Committee of Non-Teaching Staff Unions.

The presentation focused on the submission of the reviewed salary structure, the renegotiated conditions of service, and the signed agreement on the review of staff allowances and welfare in monetary terms. The agreement includes the Federal Government's approval of a 35 percent review of staff welfare and allowances for non-teaching staff.

Receiving the documents, the Vice-Chancellor of Kaduna State University, Professor Abdullahi Ibrahim Musa, welcomed the development and expressed the University's commitment to implementing the reviewed provisions.

He consequently directed the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Administration), Professor Mohammed Bashir Ali, and the Registrar, Barrister Samira Balarabe, to constitute a committee that will work towards the implementation of the reviewed working document in the University.

Speaking during the presentation, the Chairperson of NASU, KASU Branch, Nina Ochijbo, alongside the Branch Secretary, Dahiru Musa, Branch Treasurer, Salisu Bala, and the National Executive Committee Member, Musa Josiah Kalla, commended the University Management for its support and reaffirmed the Union's commitment to promoting the welfare of non-teaching staff through constructive engagement.



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
