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Outgoing KASU Governing Council Holds Valedictory Session, Appreciates Governor Uba Sani's Support to Kaduna State University

The Governing Council of Kaduna State University has held a valedictory session to mark the end of its tenure, reflecting on its achievements while expressing appreciation to the Visitor to the University and Governor of Kaduna State, Senator Uba Sani, for his unwavering support towards the growth and development of the institution.

Chairman of the Governing Council, Dr. Hussaini Adamu Dikko said that despite the challenges encountered during its tenure, the Council remained focused on strengthening the University through sound governance, strategic appointments and policies that advanced the institution's mandate. He noted that the Council successfully carried out the full gamut of statutory appointments and expressed satisfaction with the performance of the management and staff.

Dr. Dikko stressed that every decision taken by the Council was guided by the overall interest of Kaduna State University and the vision of its founding fathers to build a world-class institution.

According to him, the Council is leaving behind a stronger university with a solid foundation for future growth.



The outgoing Council Chairman acknowledged that one of the major issues that remained unresolved was the inability to hold a convocation ceremony during its tenure. He, however, expressed confidence that the incoming Governing Council would address the matter

Vice-Chancellor, Professor Abdullahi Ibrahim Musa, said the second quarter of 2026 witnessed sustained progress across the University's core mandates of teaching, research, innovation, community service and institutional development. According to him, the achievements recorded during the period underscored Kaduna State University's commitment to academic excellence, quality assurance, digital transformation, infrastructure development, staff and student development, as well as strategic partnerships.

Professor Musa attributed the successes recorded to the unwavering support of the Visitor to the University and Governor of Kaduna State, Senator Uba Sani, the guidance of the outgoing Pro-Chancellor and members of the Governing Council, and the dedication of the University's management, staff, students, alumni, development partners and other stakeholders. He thanked the Council for providing purposeful leadership throughout its tenure.

The Vice-Chancellor reaffirmed Management's commitment to consolidating the gains recorded by strengthening academic excellence, expanding research and innovation, accelerating digital transformation, improving infrastructure, enhancing internally generated revenue, deepening strategic partnerships and promoting prudent governance in pursuit of Kaduna State University's vision of becoming a globally recognised institution distinguished for excellence, innovation and service to humanity.

The newly constituted Council is expected to build on the achievements of its predecessor and provide strategic direction for the continued growth and development of Kaduna State University.
