Kaduna State University Advances Kaduna's Development Agenda with Creation of Centre for Kaduna Studies

Kaduna State University (KASU) has appointed Professor Wuam Terhemba, a Professor of Economic History, as the pioneer Director of the newly established Centre for Kaduna Studies, a multidisciplinary think tank created to drive research and provide evidence-based solutions to the developmental challenges of Kaduna State.

The establishment of the Centre was approved by the University's Governing Council following the presentation of its five-year strategic plan, which outlines a roadmap for its growth and operations.

The Centre for Kaduna Studies is envisioned as a hub for research, documentation, teaching, and capacity building. It will focus on key areas including the economy, security, science and technology, culture, education, governance, and other sectors critical to the sustainable development of Kaduna State.

Working collaboratively with academic departments, government institutions, development partners, and other

stakeholders, the Centre will generate policy-relevant research and practical solutions to issues affecting the state.

The Centre also seeks to position itself as a leading sub-national institution for development research by attracting competitive grants, strategic partnerships, and other resources to complement the University's initial funding.



Following his appointment, the Vice-Chancellor, Professor Abdullahi

Ibrahim Musa, charged Professor Terhemba to assemble a competent team and hit the ground running in actualising the Centre's vision and strategic objectives.

Professor Musa expressed confidence that the Centre would contribute significantly to Kaduna State's socio-economic transformation through impactful research, innovation, and policy engagement.

He also commended the Governor of Kaduna State and Visitor to the University, Senator Uba Sani, for his exemplary leadership and sustained support to the University, noting that the establishment of the Centre complements the state's development agenda by providing research-driven solutions to contemporary challenges.

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
