The Vice Chancellor of Kaduna State University (KASU), Professor Abdullahi Ibrahim Musa, has sought the partnership and collaboration of the Petroleum Technology Development Fund (PTDF) to further advance the development of the institution.

Professor Musa made the call when he led the management team of the University on a visit to the PTFD, where he highlighted areas of mutual interest and opportunities for collaboration that could contribute to the growth and development of the University.
